OUR STUDENTS HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED TO THE FOLLOWING UNIVERSITIES





















As of April 2021, our college readiness rate in reading is 70% based on the FLD0E's criteria of a **19** ACT Reading or a **430** on the SAT Reading and Writing.

This means that 70% of our students are in a position to be accepted by a college or university based on their college entrance exams. We look forward to sharing our end-of-year college acceptance rate in our 4th quarter report. Last year we had a 93% college acceptance rate for our William M Raines cohort and this year we are on track to increase our percentage rate.




CCD 2020 seniors had a **100**% Graduation Readiness Rate which outperforms the state of Florida's graduation rate over the past 5 years:






COLLEGE ENTRANCE EXAMS


A greater proportion of the CCD high school seniors took post-secondary readiness exams (ACT and SAT) than the comparison group who attended the same school.





AFTER STARTING COLLEGE AND CAREER DREAMS:

The CCD student outperformed the comparison group 793 to 744 on the Lexile Reading Assessment, which translates to approximately **a half school year more reading growth** than the comparison group.



Despite starting at approximately the same place, our students improved their reading abilities by **49 more points** than the comparison group in the same time-frame within the same school.

Reading Lexile Assessment is a good indicator of improvements in reading ability and was captured at the mid year point for the students after our program had been in place for about 3 months.




BEFORE STARTING COLLEGE AND CAREER DREAMS:

Schools use the Achieve platform to predict how students will perform on the Florida Standards

Assessment. The higher the Achieve Score, the more likely they can predict a student's FSA score.


At the start of the school year, the comparison group of students and the CCD students earned a similar score on the Achieve Platform [comparison is equivalent to a 2 on the FSA and the CCR group was equivalent to a 1.9).
